



# VACCINES FOR NEVADA MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENTS

**IF YOUR CHILD IS HEADING TO MIDDLE SCHOOL THIS FALL**, it's time to think about school vaccines. Now is the time to establish a primary care provider and schedule an appointment to get up to date on school vaccinations.

Recommended Vaccines for Adolescents:		
<b>Tdap*</b> (1 dose)	<b>MenACWY*</b> (1 dose)	<b>Flu</b> (Annually)
<b>HPV</b> (2-3 doses)	<b>COVID-19</b> (Pfizer vaccine authorized for those 12+)	

**NEVADA LAW REQUIRES CERTAIN IMMUNIZATIONS** (those marked \*) for public school entry – unless exempt due to a medical condition or religious belief. Other listed vaccines are recommended for middle school students to help ensure good health.

**WORRIED ABOUT PAYING FOR VACCINES?** Many Nevada healthcare providers offer vaccines at low or no cost to parents as part of the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program (Younger than 19 years of age).
